

## **OVERVIEW**

The client is an airport situated on the Eastern seaboard, servicing millions of passengers per year. The airport was a longtime user of Constructware, which was reaching end of life in late 2021. Stellar was contracted by the airport's engineering firm to select a software to replace Constructware.

## **APPROACH**

Stellar worked with the engineering firm to create a requirements list for the potential new construction management software. The team worked to understand the "as-is" business processes and created the "to-be" processes.

## SOLUTION

All parties agreed to replace Constructware with Kahua. A major factor in the decision was the fact that the new software would have over 1,000 users. In addition, the team needed to confirm that the software could comply with the airport's security and network requirements.

## **RESULTS**

The airport was able to smoothly transition from Constructware to Kahua. After the software was chosen, our team migrated over 2 terabytes of content, metadata, folder structures, in flight workflows, contacts, financials, and other information.
